East Valley nonprofits given grants by credit union

OneAZ Credit Union awarded grants to 33 nonprofits around the state, including five in the East Valley.

The grants were awarded to Boys & Girls Clubs of the East Valley in Mesa, Chandler/Gilbert Arc in Chandler, Child Crisis Arizona in Mesa, Neighborhood Ministries in Tempe and the Salvation Army Chandler Corps in Gilbert.

The statewide grants totaled \$50,000. The grants are expected to fund programs that provide a direct benefit to the communities served to enhance the quality of life, according to a press release.
